

Coastal Way kept clear thanks to grant from the Auchrannie Charitable Trust

'Shiskine Valley Improvements' is the latest organisation on Arran to have been awarded a grant by the Auchrannie Charitable Trust (The ACT). The donation of $\pounds1,600$ has allowed the group to purchase two brushcutters.

The vibrant Shiskine Valley community group, manned entirely by volunteers has responsibility for looking after an area of the coastal way through Blackwaterfood and the equipment will be used to help maintain a five mile stretch between Brown Head and Kings Cave.

This particular stretch is particularly popular with visitors to the island as well as the many locals who use it on a regular basis. Keeping the area clear of braken and briars will help make it more accessible for all users.
