

Whiting Bay Bowling Club increase accessibility with grant from the Auchrannie Charitable Trust

'Whiting Bay Bowling Club' is the latest organisation on Arran to have been awarded a grant by the Auchrannie Charitable Trust (The ACT). The funds will be used specifically to assist in increasing accesibility at the club.

Works undertaken as a result of the grant include a wheelchair ramp, new seating and a 'Bowlsmate' which will allow those with knee issues to continue to play.

The club is open to members and visitors of all ages and aims to help improve the wellbeing of the community. Making enhancements to the accessiblity of the club will ensure that bowls can be enjoyed by ever more people on Arran.

Jan Young (Whiting Bay bowling club treasurer) reacting to news of the grant said, "This grant allows us to encourage a broader spectrum of people to use the club. And, by improving the seating area we can provide opportunities for people who are at risk of social isolation to join us as spectators in a safe and friendly manner."
